However, the tour must be completed with the same aircraft, with normal simulator speed (accelerated flights are not allowed), and the flight must be logged by means of your Virtual Airline flight tracking system.

Circumnavigating the globe is really fun, as long as you understand your aircraft limitations, invest a lot of time in the tour, and by planning each leg properly. Pilots may use their own route waypoints for each flight leg.

Once completed, please complete the World Tour tracking sheet (which is available on our website) and email it to your hub manager for evaluation, after which we will award you with the appropriate tour accomplishment badge.
